## SCHEDULING THE BAPTISM

Your first step in scheduling a Baptism is to call the Parish Office at 505-662-6193 and schedule an appointment with Fr. John C. Daniel.

- At this meeting, you will be provided with information on how to choose Godparents, and you will be able to schedule the Baptism at this time.
- Please bring your child's Birth Certificate or Proof of Birth to the meeting. If you have already chosen Godparents please bring this information to the meeting.
- Baptisms are normally scheduled at the meeting with Fr. John Daniel and can take place in the celebration of a Mass or at another time of your choosing. Know that the Priest and Deacons of our Parish are open to accommodating your needs.
- The Baptismal Certificate will be issued on the day of the Baptism, after the Ceremony. A Baptismal Candle is also provided for you on the day of Baptism.
- The Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Class, our Parish has one on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of January, March, May, July, September, & November. Classes are held at 7:30 PM at St. Joseph's Church in White Rock (the Mission of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish). If you have any questions or would like more information, please contact the Parish Office at 505-662-6193. Also, if you need to attend a Baptismal Class at a different time please contact the Parish Office and Fr. John Daniel will be able to provide a class that will work with your schedule.

The role of the Godparents in the life of your child is a very important one, they are called to help you share your Faith with your child. But they are also called upon to be a model of how to live the life of faith in our society. May they be a mentor to your child and a helping hand to you.

### GODPARENT (SPONSOR) REQUIREMENTS

Please note that at least one Godparent is needed. If there are two Godparents one must be male and the other female. Also, along with a Godparent there can be a Christian Witness. What follows are the eligibility requirements for Godparents in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe.

Each Godparent should:

- Be a Baptized member of the Catholic Church.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Have received the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation.
- Not married outside the Catholic Church, nor living outside of marriage with someone.
- Be embracing the Sacraments of our Faith.
- Live a life in harmony with the teachings of the Catholic Faith and the role that is to be undertaken.
